In its falls from Christ, the soul needs the refuge it finds in the Mother of Mercy. In the sacrifices and sorrows it undergoes for Christ, it needs the support of the Mother of Sorrows. In the understanding of, and adherence to, the lofty ideals of Christ, it needs the perfect reflection of them that it finds in the Immaculate Heart of Mary – the Virgin, Queen and the Mother.

MAJOR ARCHBISHOP, HIS BEATITUDE, SVIATOSLAV'S, FIRST PASTORAL VISIT TO THE EPARCHY OF NEW WESTMINSTER, BRITISH COLUMBIA

AUGUST 29 to SEPTEMBER 4, 2012

New Westminster British Columbia—The spiritual leader of the world's Six million Ukrainian Catholics, will be visiting the New Westminster, Richmond, Vancouver and Kelowna Ukrainian Catholic Parishes which are part of the Eparchy (Diocese) of New Westminster. The New Westminster Eparchy has 13 parishes around the province and more than 7,500 faithful followers.

'We are so pleased to announce that the Major Archbishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Church, His Beatitude, Sviatoslav, will help commemorate the one hundredth anniversary of the Servant of God, Martyr, Blessed Bishop Nykyta Budka's appointment as the first Ukrainian Catholic Bishop of Canada (October 14, 1912). A hard working group of community volunteers, laity, clergy and religious are preparing for the Major Archbishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Church, His Beatitude, Sviatoslav's, first Pastoral visit with his arrival on this Labour Day Weekend.

- He will bless the newly renovated Bishop Jerome Chimy Eparchial Centre in New Westminster on Friday August 31. That same evening, there will be a prayer service and reception at Holy Eucharist Cathedral in New Westminster (501 - 4 Avenue).
- **He will be the main celebrant at the Hierarchical Divine Liturgy at the Protection of the Blessed Virgin Mary (St. Mary's) Ukrainian Catholic Church in Vancouver (560 West 14 Avenue) at 10:00 AM on Saturday September 1, 2012. A formal banquet will follow in the parish hall. The Banquet is reserved seating for only 400 persons. Tickets for this event are \$60/ticket with a \$30 tax receipt. - The Major Archbishop will be in Kelowna, Sunday, September 2, at the Dormition of the Mother of God Church (1091 Coronation Avenue) where he will be the main celebrant at the Hierarchical Divine Liturgy at 11:00 AM. A formal banquet will follow for which tickets must be purchased.
