A Reading from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians (8:8-9:2)

Brethren, food will not bring us close to God. We are no worse off if we do not eat, and no better off if we do. But take care that this liberty of yours does not somehow become a stumbling block to the weak. For if others see you, who possess knowledge, eating in the temple of an idol, might they not, since their conscience is weak, be encouraged to the point of eating food sacrificed to idols? So by your knowledge those weak believers for whom Christ died are destroyed. But when you thus sin against members of your family, and wound their conscience when it is weak, you sin against Christ.

Therefore, if food is a cause of their falling, I will never eat meat, so that I may not cause one of them to fall. Am I not free? Am I not an apostle? Have I not seen Jesus our Lord? Are you not my work in the Lord? If I am not an apostle to others, at least I am to you; for you are the seal of my apostleship in the Lord.

Then they also will answer, 'Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not take care of you?' Then he will answer them, 'Truly I tell you, just as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me.' And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

Statement on Physician-Assisted Suicide by the Most Reverend Paul-André Durocher, Archbishop of Gatineau and President of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops

Catholics are called by their faith to assist all those in need, particularly the poor, the suffering and the dying. Comforting the dying and accompanying them in love and solidarity has been considered by the Church since its beginning a principal expression of Christian mercy.

Helping someone commit suicide, however, is neither an act of justice or mercy, nor is it part of palliative care. The decision of the Supreme Court of Canada today does not change Catholic teaching. “[A]n act or omission which, of itself or by intention, causes death in order to eliminate suffering constitutes a murder gravely contrary to the dignity of the human person and to the respect due to the living God, our Creator.” (*Catechism of the Catholic Church*, 2277).

The Bishops of our country invite Canadians, especially Catholics, to do all they can to bring comfort and support for all those who are dying and for their loved ones, so that no one, because of loneliness, vulnerability, loss of autonomy, or fear of pain and suffering, feels they have no choice but to commit suicide. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops will continue to promote palliative and home care, and to encourage all the faithful to work for the betterment of the elderly, the disabled, the ill, and those who are socially isolated.

My brother Bishops and I entreat governments and courts to interpret today’s judgment in its narrowest terms, resisting any calls to go beyond this to so-called acts of “mercy killing” and euthanasia. We again call on provincial and territorial governments to ensure good-quality palliative care in all their jurisdictions. We also urge governments and professional associations to implement policies and guidelines which ensure respect for the freedom of conscience of all health-care workers as well as administrators who will not and cannot accept suicide as a medical solution to pain and suffering.

КАТЕХИЗМ УГКЦ – ХРИСТОС – НАША ПАСХА

Пришестя Христа у славі

250 На суді синедріону Христос, відповідаючи на питання первосвященика Каяфи, чи Він «Син Благословенного» (Мр. 14, 61), наводить слова пророка Даниїла про прихід у славі Сина Людського: «І побачите Сина Чоловічого, який сидітиме праворуч Всемогутнього та йтиме на хмарах небесних» (Мр. 14, 62; пор. Дан. 7, 13). Після Вознесіння Христового ангели сповістили апостолам: «Оцей Ісус, Який від вас був узятий на небо, так само прийде, як ви Його бачили відходячого на небо» (Ді. 1, 11). Як у людській природі Він вознісся до божественної слави, так у тій же прославленій людській природі прийде судити.

251 У славному Пришесті (грецькою – *парусія*) Христа Суд над «живими і мертвими» стане благословенням для праведників. На Суді бо відкриється і стане явним усе таємне і приховане: «Нічого бо нема схованого, що б не відкрилось, і скритого, що б не виявилось» (Лк. 12, 2–3).

252 Славне друге Пришестя Христа несе зі собою також прославлення людини (див. Кл. 3, 4), яке є сповненням обожествлення, осягненням «повноти Христа» (Еф. 4, 13). Христос розпочав прославлення людини у Своїм Воскресінні, а відтак – в історії Церкви у свідченні святих: «Христос із мертвих устав, як начало померлих, первородний творіння, Творець всього, що існує, Він і нашу зотлілу природу обнови в Собі»¹, а тоді у відповідь «як первістки єства вселенна приносить Насадителю творіння ... богоносних мучеників»².

0.6.2.4.1. Присутність воскреслого Христа

253 Воскреслий Христос заповів апостолам: «Отож Я з вами по всі дні аж до кінця віку» (Мт. 28, 20). Христос завжди присутній у Своїй Церкві, зокрема у святих Таїнствах, у Слові Святого Письма, у літургійній спільноті, у подвижницькому житті святих і їхніх мощах та у святих іконах. Воскреслий Христос дарує нам благодать відродження і нового життя, як навчає апостол Павло, у нас помирає «стара» й воскресає «нова» людина у Христі: «Хоч наша зовнішня людина занепадає, однак наша внутрішня обновлюється день-у-день» (2 Кр. 4, 16). Зодягнувшись у Христа у Хрещенні (див. Рм. 6), людина зростає до «міри повного зросту повноти Христа» (Еф. 4, 13), коли за апостолом Павлом може стверджувати: «Живу вже не я, а живе Христос у мені» (Гл. 2, 20).

254 Силою воскресіння Христового смерть людини стає переходом (пасхою) до вічного життя: «Нема страху повернення в землю, з якої Бог вивів до висот нетління Своїм воскресінням»³. Запорукою подолання смерті і тління є Сам Христос: «Я – воскресіння і життя. Хто в Мене вірує, той навіть і вмерши – житиме! Кожен, хто живе і в Мене вірує, – не вмере повіки» (Йо. 11, 25–26).

There is a keen interest in reviving our Eparchial Youth Club and I would like to support this initiative. At this time there is a core group of young people under the supervision of Fr. Richard Soo, sj of our parish in Richmond and Ms. Ivana Tokar of our parish in Vancouver with Miss Christine Loutsik of our Cathedral parish as president. Currently the Youth Club has committed to activities in the Lower Mainland at least twice monthly. Membership is open to those between 13–18 years of age with permission from their parents. If your children are interested in deepening their religious and Christian commitment with others their age and participate in spiritual and cultural activities throughout the year, please contact your local parish priest for more details. There has been a keen interest expressed by our clergy and several of our young people and their parents to organize an Eparchial youth group that would participate in the 25–31 July 2016 World Youth Day with His Holiness Pope Francis in Krakow, Poland.

World Youth Day (WYD) is a worldwide encounter with Pope which is typically celebrated every three years in a different country. The most recent WYD was celebrated in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil from July 23rd to 28th, 2013 and the next World Youth Day will be held in Krakow, Poland in 2016. WYD is open to all young people who want to take part in a festive encounter with their contemporaries centered on Jesus Christ. This event is an opportunity to experience in first person the universality of the Church; to share with the whole world the hope of many young people who want to commit themselves to Christ and others. World Youth Day is a unique way to deepen your faith and grow closer to Christ, by means of prayer and sacraments, together with thousands of other young people who share your interests and ambitions. During the week of World Youth Day, there will be a complete cultural agenda in addition to the events with the Pope.

Our Eparchy is inviting participants who will be 16 years of age by June 30, 2016 but not older than 22 as of December 31, 2016 to be part of the youth group attending from our Eparchy. The youth from our Eparchy will be accompanied by adult supervisors as well as a few parents. If you have a child that will be 16 years old by June 30 2016 or you are now 18 years old or older and would like to participate, there will be a special informational meeting at 5:00 pm on Sunday, 22 February in the basement hall of Holy Eucharist Cathedral, located at 501–4th Avenue, New Westminster. Youth are cordially invited to attend as well, and then at 5:30 pm to go to Sisters Angelica & Daria's (Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate) home at the other end of the block for an opportunity to pray in front of the pilgrimage Icon of Blessed Josaphat (their foundress) and enjoy some pizza! Christ is Born!

Dear Friends, We have received some wonderful news this week that I would like to share with you. On February 11, **Sister Pat Lacey ssmi**, the Provincial Superior for all of the Sisters Servants of Mary Immaculate (SSMI) in Canada will be arriving in Vancouver and bringing with her a very special icon.

In August 2013, **His Beatitude Patriarch Sviatoslav**, blessed a special icon of the Co-Foundress of the SSMI, **Blessed Josaphata Hordashevskia** at the Patriarchal Sobor in Kyiv, Ukraine. It is a pilgrimage icon with an embedded relic of Blessed Josaphata. This icon was written in honour of the upcoming 125th anniversary of the founding of the SSMI, which will take place in August of 2017. The special icon has already travelled to our faithful in Argentina, Brazil and the United States of America. The Sisters hope to have this icon travel to all of the countries, to the Eparchies and places where the Sisters have or are currently serving. The icon will be in our Eparchy for just over two weeks. The icon will travel across Canada over the next few months before departing to Poland in August of this year.

Sister Josaphata Hordashevskia was beatified by **Saint Pope John Paul II**, when he visited Ukraine in 2001. Declaration of beatification is the final step toward canonization, or the declaration of Sainthood. **Below you will find the times and places you and your family invited to pray in front of the Icon:** So if you or someone you know is in the Lower Mainland or on the Island please make your plans and come and pray!
