Of course, money, food, drink, comfort, wealth, relationships, and other blessings have their place in life, but they are not to become what life is about. If we make them false gods, we will destroy ourselves and lose them also because only God is God. No part of creation finds peace or fulfillment unless it is offered to Him for blessing in accordance with His purposes for it. And that includes you and me.

There is no path to the richness of the Kingdom apart from us growing in holiness, when we fast, pray, and give generously to the needy as well as when we are on guard for even the most subtle temptations to place the world before God.

Epistle: A Reading from Saint Paul's letter to the Ephesians (Ephesians 5:9-19):

Brothers and Sisters, live as children of light for the fruit of the light is found in all that is good and right and true. Try to find out what is pleasing to the Lord. Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them. For it is shameful even to mention what such people do secretly; but everything exposed by the light becomes visible, for everything that becomes visible is light. Therefore it says, "Sleeper, awake! Rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you." Be careful then how you live, not as unwise people but as wise, making the most of the time, because the days are evil. So do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.
