Feast of the Mother of God of Perpetual Help

On December 11, 2017, His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Major Archbishop of Kyiv and Halych, officially proclaimed that the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church celebrates the Feast of the Mother of God of Perpetual Help every year on the first Sunday of July.

The decision to include the Feast of the Mother of God of Perpetual Help in the worldwide Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church was taken by the Major Archbishop and all the Bishops gathered in Synod in September 2017. It was proclaimed on the official website of the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church on December 11, remembering that on this date in 1865, Pope Pius IX entrusted the Icon to the care of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorist Fathers).

Please note: In order to participate at a Sunday Liturgy; you cannot show up for the service you must do the following:

You must pre-register for a particular Sunday Divine Liturgy (either 8:30 or 10:30) by contacting the parish office either by email: office@stmarysbc.com or by phone at 604-879-5830.

·Give the names of all who will be attending. You must receive a confirmation of your attendance, either by phone or by email. If you have not received confirmation of registration, please do not show up at the church.

·You must pre-register for a Sunday Divine Liturgy by 2:00 PM on the Friday before each weekend.

At the time of registering please let the parish office know if you use a walker or wheelchair, or otherwise need assistance in entering the church.

Singing led by a single cantor

(from the "Directives for the Re-opening of the Churches..." it is an additional reminder of thoses points)

38. Congregational and choral (choir) singing is a high-risk activity and is not allowed because infected people can transmit the virus through their saliva or respiratory droplets.

39. Instead, the sung responses during the liturgical services may be led by a single cantor, while the faithful remain prayerfully silent.

40. A designated area, completely separated from the faithful, must be set aside for the cantor, as singing disperses droplets in a wider area than speaking.

41. Where the parish has chosen to recite the entire Divine Liturgy, the faithful may actively participate in the responses, provided that physical distancing is maintained.

42. Where the parish recites some parts of the Divine Liturgy and sings others, again, the sung parts are to be led by a single cantor, while the faithful remain prayerfully silent.
