From the beginning of Russia's full-scale war against Ukraine, the Basilian monasteries in Ukraine have accepted many displaced families that arrived from the eastern part of Ukraine, where most of the bombing is still taking place. Very Rev. Genesio Viomar, OSBM, the General Superior of the Order of St. Basil the Great announced, "The Basilian monasteries (in Ukraine) are ready to accept the refugees from the regions of Ukraine that are engulfed in the war. Although our abilities are limited, the doors of the monasteries are open to you, dear Brothers and Sisters."

The Basilian Fathers in Canada, Sacred Heart Province, also express deep concerns and pray for the end of the war in Ukraine. We pray for the innocent victims of war, among whom are many children, women and elderly people.

We call upon the Parishioners of Basilian Parishes, and all who are interested, to help the forcibly displaced people of Ukraine in any way possible.
