Св. священномученик Йосафат (Кунцевич) - архієпископ Полоцький

12 листопада вшановуємо пам'ять святого священномученика Йосафата. Іван Кунцевич народився 1580 року у Володимирі-Волинському. У 24 роки він вступив до монастиря Святої Трійці у Вільні та отримав монаше ім'я Йосафат. У 1609 році Кунцевича висвятили на священника.

Помер священник у 1623 році від побиття противниками церковної єдності. Біля тіла мученика почали діятися чуда. У 1643 році Папа Урбан VIII проголосив

Йосафата Блаженним, а через 224 роки Папа Пій IX прилучив Йосафата до лику святих Вселенської Церкви.

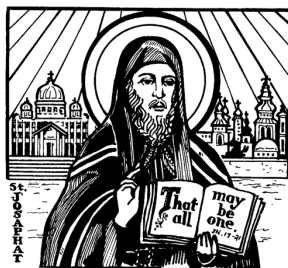
Перенесення мощів українського святого до собору Св. Петра у Ватикані відбулося в листопаді 1963 року. Їхня історія є надзвичайно складною: після смерті Йосафата вони перебували в різних місцях Литви, Польщі і Білорусії. У 1916 році їх перевозять у костел Св. Варвари у Відні, а у 1949-му потрапляють з Австрії до Рима, де згодом були виставлені для загального почитання у соборі Св. Петра, у вітварі правої сторони престолу св. Василія Великого.

За словами сучасників, Йосафат Кунцевич був чудовим проповідником, турботливим пастирем, відданим справі спасіння віруючих і єдності між християнами. У 1923 р. Папа Пій XI присвятив йому енцикліку під назвою “Ecclesiam Dei” (“Церква Божа”). У ній понтифік підкреслював приклад його особистої святості, життя в чистоті і бідності.

Крім того, Йосафат користувався великою повагою за свої інтелектуальні здібності. Під його редакцією виходили численні тексти про першість Св. Петра, єдність Церкви, хрещення св. Володимира. Він видав катехизм і намагався адаптувати проповідь Євангелія до особливостей менталітету місцевого населення.

Папа Римський Іван Павло II назвав Кунцевича “апостолом єднання”. Св. Йосафат вважається покровителем України.

Feast of St. Josaphat Kuntsevych - November 12

- Born in the year 1580 in Volodymyr, Lithuania.
- Entered the Basilian Fathers' Monastery of the Holy Trinity in Vilna in 1604 at the age of 24.
- Ordained a Priest in 1609 and dedicated himself to the cause of church unity.
- Consecrated as Archbishop of Polotsk (Belarus) in 1617. He worked to bring about a renewal within the church, to promote catechesis, education, good preaching, charity and service to the poor. Despite all his duties as an archbishop, he remained faithful to his monastic rule.
- Died on November 12, 1623 at the age of 44. He died a martyr's death at the hands of those who opposed the unity between Orthodox and Catholics.
- Beatified in 1643 and Canonized on June 29, 1867 by Pope Pius IX.
- The body of St. Josaphat is found in St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, at the Altar of St. Basil the Great.
