Prayer for Ukraine

O Lord Jesus Christ, grant peace and protection to the people of Ukraine. Give them strength and courage to defend what is good, right, and holy. Keep them safe from harm and provide for all their needs, both temporal and spiritual.

Soften the hearts of the unmerciful and convert those who promote hostilities toward reconciliation, so that your beloved children of Ukraine may abide in that tranquility, justice and freedom which reflects your Kingdom. Lord, hear us, and have mercy.

Fourth Sunday of Great Lent Reflection from the Lenten Triodion - Vespers

Having passed half the distance of this holy fast, let us hasten to its completion in joy; let us anoint our souls with oil for the struggle, that we may be worthy to venerate the holy passion of Christ our God and to contemplate His glorious resurrection.

Having passed the midpoint of this fast, let us manifest the beginning of conversion, so that at the end of a holy life we may find happiness that does not pass away.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

The One who planted the vineyard and called the laborers is the Saviour Whom we shall see soon; come, let us receive the recompense of our labours in this fast, for the Master remunerates generously from his heart; even though we have laboured only a short time, we shall receive great mercy for your souls.

Prayer of St. Ephrem (Prayed during the period of Great Lent)

O Lord and Master of my life, keep from me the spirit of indifference and discouragement, lust for power, and idle chatter. (Prostration)

Instead, grant to me, Your servant, the spirit of wholeness of being, humble-mindedness, patience and love. (Prostration)

O Lord and King, grant me the grace to be aware of my sins and not to judge my neighbour, for You are blessed, now and for ever and ever. Amen. (Prostration)

(Then the following prayer is repeated four times)

God, be merciful to me, a sinner.

God, cleanse me of my sins and have mercy of me. I have sinned without number, forgive me, O Lord.

Once more the entire Prayer of St. Ephrem is recited without the usual prostrations.

One prostration is made at the conclusion.
