In preparation for the Christmas Fair, the young adults will be organizing a few pyrohy (perogy) making sessions. If you are free on the dates below we would love for you to join us.

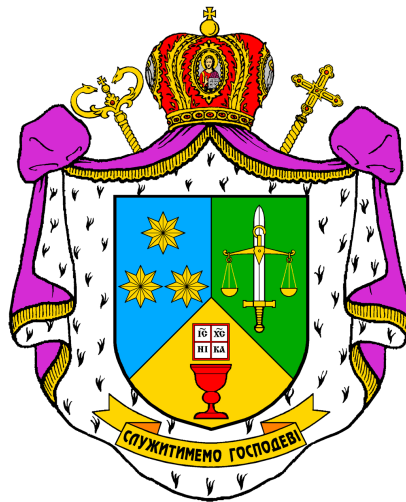
