The Divine Liturgy (part 1)

The Divine Liturgy of St. John Chrysostom has three parts:

Proskomedia: the priest prepares himself, the bread and the wine for the sacrifice. The bread is called Prosphora and is cut into hosts representing Jesus and others. The wine mixed with water symbolizes Jesus' blood and water. The bread and wine is incensed and covered with veils. This part signifies Jesus' birth and life.

Liturgy of the Word: the faithful listen to the readings from the Scriptures and the homily of the priest. This part signifies Jesus' teaching and preaching.

Liturgy of the Faithful: the priest consecrates the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ and distributes them to the faithful. This part signifies Jesus' death and resurrection.
