A Word from the Youth Group at Holy Eucharist Cathedral Project: #SaveUkrainianSoldier

#SaveUkrainianSoldier is an international volunteer group founded in Vancouver, Canada, partnering with like-minded Ukrainian field volunteer groups.

This project began immediately following the Russian invasion in February 2022 and focuses on providing tactical medical supplies to Ukrainian frontlines. This group addresses a critical lack of life saving tools such as: tourniquets, occlusive chest seals, hemostatic bandages and applicators, compression bandages, airways, decompression needle kits, tourniquets, intraosseous access systems, and other essential components of tactical first aid kits and paramedic backpacks.

#SaveUkrainianSoldier is not a formal organization or charity fund, but rather a group of like-minded individuals developing a direct helping relationship with Ukrainian battlefield medics. The goal is to fill a critical gap promptly, when timing matters the most, bypassing red tape bureaucracy of official charitable funds and government aid agencies.

This group monitors the needs of battlefield medics by direct personal communication. Once a request for supplies has been received, they are purchased promptly in US/Canadian stores, with expedited shipment to Ukraine, where partner volunteers deliver these supplies directly. Extra supplies are also being gathered with partner volunteer warehouses in Ukraine to be readily available. This "fast track" usually takes from a few days to a few weeks from the request to actual delivery, hands to hands with photo and video proof available on social media for all donors and helpers.

For the period of March 2022 - January 2024, through active non-stop fundraising efforts in Canada, the #SaveUkrainianSoldier group was able to purchase medical supplies, shipping hundreds of parcels to frontline medics, each containing exactly what they needed according to their request.

You can be part of this project as well. You can save a life and help a Ukrainian soldier to see his family again.
