The Basilian Order of St. Josaphat (Basilian Fathers) holds its Provincial chapter

From February 5 - 9, 2024, The Canadian Province of the Basilian Order of St. Josaphat (Basilian Fathers) held its Provincial Chapter in Vancouver, British Columbia.

The Chapter, a series of meetings which normally takes place every four years, is a time during which Basilian delegates from across Canada meet to review, evaluate and discuss their work in the various areas of the apostolate in which they are engaged across Canada.

At the same time the Chapter elects a Provincial Council which will oversee and direct, in keeping with the Basilian Statutes and the Chapter Resolutions, the work of the Basilian Order in Canada. The new Council consists of:

Prayer of St. Ephrem (Prayed during the period of Great Lent)

O Lord and Master of my life, keep from me the spirit of indifference and discouragement, lust for power,

and idle chatter. (Prostration)

Instead, grant to me, Your servant, the spirit of wholeness of being, humble-mindedness, patience and love. (Prostration)

O Lord and King, grant me the grace to be aware of my sins and not to judge my neighbour, for You are blessed, now and for ever and ever.

Amen. (Prostration)

(Then with a simple bow the following prayer is repeated four times)

God, be merciful to me, a sinner.

God, cleanse me of my sins and have mercy of me.

I have sinned without number, forgive me, O Lord.

Then the entire Prayer of St. Ephrem is recited without the usual prostrations.

One prostration is made at the end.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, now and for ever and ever. Amen.

Let us begin the time of this bright Fast, giving ourselves over to spiritual struggle. Let us sanctify our soul and purify our flesh. Let us not fast only from food; let us also abstain from every passion and cultivate spiritual virtues. And let us faithfully persevere in this, so that we may be worthy to see the holy passion of Christ our God and the joy of His holy resurrection.
