Have you Believed...

Thomas Sunday's Gospel is proclaiming the appearance of the risen Lord to His disciples eight days after the Resurrection when Thomas was then present and proclaimed "My Lord and my God" upon seeing the hands and side of Christ. In the Church services for this day, the stress is on the Apostle Thomas' vision of Christ and the significance of the words of Jesus: "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe".

Early History of St Mary's Ukrainian Catholic Parish (part 5)





After the growth spurt of building; the 1000 strong parishioners of S Mary's Parish turn to celebrating. **Michael Tartarniuk** coordinated the Millennium Project (the Millennium of Christianity for Ukrainians in(988 AD) 1988) Which produced **the Ukrainian Catholic churches and organizations in BC (1891-1992)** book. It is a story of the faith of the pioneers, their loyalty to their church and of the sacrifices they made to enable their children to have a better way of life. The parish celebrated its **60th Anniversary, (1927-1987**) and the 50th anniversary of the Basilian Order (1938-1988)

The parish Choir participated in the **1988 Millennium Celebrations** in Rome under the direction of **Bill Smigel**. The St Mary's Choir also performed throughout the lower mainland and BC.

In July 1992 four mosaics were installed; St Andrew blessing the hills of Kiev (North East wall) Baptism of Ukraine (south-east wall) Consecration of Rus Ukraine 1030 AD by Yaroslav the Wise (south west wall) Evolution of the St Mary's Parish (north west wall).

St Mary's parishioners were involved in the Centennial celebration of Ukrainian settlement in Canada with music, dance, and crafts at the Pacific National Exhibition, Vancouver, **August 1992** and **Showcase 2000** highlighted Ukrainian arts and crafts on the plaza of nations

In 2002 the Parish celebrated its **75 anniversary of the Parish**, and **65th anniversary of the Basilian Fathers** serving the parish and the **60th anniversary of the Parish Choir**. In 2010 the Parish Center was home to **Ukrainian House** for the **2010 Winter Olympics**. Many Olympic spectators from around the world and Canadian fans visited the House and our Church. In **2012** the parish welcomed the historic visit of **Major Archbishop Sviatoslav** of leader of Ukrainian Catholics in the world. The same year we are also commemorating the **one hundredth anniversary** of the appointment of Canada's first Ukrainian Catholic, **Bishop Nykyta Budka**, returned to Ukraine and was later arrested and sent to a concentration camp by the communist regime where he died. Pope John Paul II, in 2001, during his visit to Ukraine elevated Bishop Budka and 24 others to "Blessed Martyr".
