### **Pilgrim Icon of the Sacred Heart of Jesus**

The Knights of Columbus Pilgrim Icon of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, will be at our Parish at the end of June.

For the Feast of the Christ Lover of Mankind (Sacred Heart of Jesus) on June 29th, members of the Knights of Columbus community and their families have been invited to attend and experience the Moleben and Divine Liturgy.

Next Sunday we sincerely ask that Parishioners make an extra effort to be in Church by 10:00 am to pray the Moleben together as one in Christ.

The Pilgrim Icon, which will be in our church, depicts the most famous image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, painted in 1767 by Pompeo Batoni and now venerated in the Church of the Gesù in Rome. The reproduction bears the blessing of the late Pope Francis, through the Papal Almoner, and is one of more than 300 icons traveling across the world, for veneration and use in prayer services, including the Moleben to Christ the Lover of Mankind.

### **Eat this Bread - Drink this Cup**

Father McBride's Family Catechism

Jesus instituted the Eucharist at the Last Supper. In a mysterious manner it contains the sacrifice of his Body and Blood and enables that sacrifice to continue in history until he comes again. He entrusted the Eucharist to his Church. It remembers and makes present his saving death and Resurrection for our salvation.

The Eucharist is a Sacrament of love, a sign of unity, a paschal meal in which we consume Jesus, have our minds filled with grace, and receive the pledge of eternal life.

What are the names we use for this Sacrament? The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* gives us ten names traditionally associated with this Sacrament.

- We call it *Eucharist* because it is an act of *thanking* God for creation, salvation, and sanctification.
- We name it the *Last Supper* because that is when Jesus instituted the Eucharist.
- We recall it as the *Breaking of the Bread* because that is what Jesus did in the Upper Room, and how he revealed himself to the disciples at Emmeaus, and it was the phrase the early Christians used for Eucharist.
- We view it as the *Eucharistic assembly* since we celebrate it in community as a visible expression of the Church.
- We know it as a *memorial* of Christ's Passion, death and Resurrection. Not just a memory of the past, but making it present by the power of the Spirit and the ministry of the priest.
- We celebrate it as the *Holy Sacrifice of the Mass (Divine Liturgy)* because it makes present the one sacrifice of Jesus Christ.
- We participate in it as the *Holy and Divine Liturgy* because it is the center and most intense expression of all Christian worship.
- We adore the Eucharist as the *Most Blessed Sacrament*, reserved in the tabernacle for our continued worship and devotion.
- We take the Eucharist as *Holy Communion* wherein we are united to Christ and shaped by him into the Body of Christ, the Church.
- We witness Eucharist as *Holy Mass* a word that comes from the Latin "to send". At the end of the Eucharist the priest sends us forth to love and serve the Lord and one another and do God's will in our daily lives.

None of these ten names says it all about the Eucharist, but together, they give us a tapestry of the broad richness of what the Eucharist means.

We extol you, O Christ, Giver of life, Who for our sake changed bread into Your Body and wine into Your Blood. Today we adore Them as the incarnate God.
